TERMS OF REFERENCE

To bring together professional and lay groups concerned with the health and welfare of children and young people across the UK.

To share information, provide a discussion forum and to be a lobbying and pressure group to take forward initiatives for the welfare of children and young people.

In particular:

- 1. To meet at least twice a year to update the Group of initiatives being taken forward within each individual Group, College or Association.
- 2. To identify current issues causing concern in the media or within Parliament that can provide a opportunity for lobbying for change.
- To take forward political initiatives such as recommendations of the House of Commons Select Committees by providing a multidisciplinary view on how implementation of recommendations should be achieved.
- 4. To provide a forum that will advise on and oversee implementation of the recommendations of the National Service Framework and other relevant Government department policies.
- To provide a pressure group to encourage Primary Care Organisations and Strategic Health Authorities in commissioning the best health services for children, young people and their families.
- 6. These Terms of reference to be reviewed annually.

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
