# The Service

## **Journey through Service**

Skilled, flexible nursing team, to support areas in need of additional staffing, able to provide:

- >Expert clinical assessment
- Skilled nursing interventions.
- >Data recording.
- > Medication management
- > Patient/ carer/ professional education

#### e.g. Practical support

- > Rapid response contact
- Care planning
- > Symptom control
- > Multi-disciplinary liaison and team approach to care delivery

#### Activity/ delivery

- 1 peripatetic nurse could work 255 shifts a year.
- 75% of previous agency shifts could be covered by 3 peripatetic nurses. It is proposed that the team will increase by an additional 4 WTE.

# **Summary of Benefits**

### **For Patients**

Continuity of care, Comprehensive care provided by skilled nurses when and where they are needed.

### For healthcare system

- Reduction in agency spend releasing £40,500pa by covering 75% of agency shifts (saving £65 per shift)
